

- “For all USTA Southern 10 and under, Level 1-3 tournament play (not including Jr. Team Tennis), the required scoring format, for singles, shall be the best of two short sets (first to four and win by two), with a set tiebreak (first to seven (7) and win by two) at 4-4 in each set, and a set tiebreak (first to seven (7) and win by two) for the third.
- Doubles matches for 10 and under tournament play shall consist of a regular six (6) game set, with a set tiebreak (first to seven (7) and win by two) at 6-6, or short sets, as detailed above in singles play.”

The rationale: To be consistent with the scoring for 10 and Under tennis throughout the Section. Different scoring formats being played have been confusing for 10 and Under players moving from tournament to tournament.
